


Correlation and Covariance

Sample correlation r is a measure of the strength of the linear relationship between two variables, X and Y. The value of r will be between -1 and +1.


▲ 20/22 ▼

$$r = \frac{\sum_{i=1}^{n} (x_i - \bar{x})(y_i - \bar{y})}{\sqrt{\sum_{i=1}^{n} (x_i - \bar{x})^2} \sqrt{\sum_{i=1}^{n} (y_i - \bar{y})^2}}$$

The sign of r indicates the sign of the slope of the implied linear fit. We will use this is in chanter 6 when we consider linear








Measurement Philosophy




